

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 40-1-118, the Commissioner shall prescribe just and reasonable rates, fares, and charges for transportation by motor carriers of household goods and for all services rendered by motor carriers in connection therewith;

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 40-1-118, the tariffs therefor shall be in such form and shall be filed and published in such manner and on such notice as the Department of Public Safety may prescribe;

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 40-1-118, such tariffs shall also be subject to change on such notice and in such manner as the department may prescribe; and

WHEREAS: On April 14, 2022, the Board of Public Safety voted upon and approved the adoption of Georgia Department of Public Safety Maximum Rate Tariff No. 3 pertaining to Intrastate Rates and Charges for Household Goods to be effective beginning April 18, 2022.

**Now, therefore, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Commissioner of the Georgia Department of Public Safety, it is hereby**

**ORDERED:** That the Department of Public Safety adopt Georgia Department of Public Safety Maximum Rate Tariff No. 3 pertaining to Intrastate Rates and Charges for Household Goods to be effective beginning April 18, 2022; it is further

**ORDERED:** That notice of the adoption of said tariff and the text of said tariff be placed upon the Department’s website.
